1902

The history of Kalnapilis began in 1902, when on January 1, the German landowner Albert Foight brewed the first batch of beer at the Bergschlösschen brewery in Panevėžys, the center of Aukštaitija, famous for its brewing traditions.

2002

In 2002, Kalnapilis celebrated its 100th anniversary as a member of a new family. The company was acquired by The Danish Brewery Group, which also owned Vilniaus Tauras, as well as the legendary brewery Faxe. 2022

Today Kalnapilis is a modern brewery that can produce more than a million hectoliters of beer per year. The products are exported to more than 27 countries around the world.











Kalnapilis

This brand emerged from the historical and original name of our brewery Bergschlösschen, which in German translates to castle on the hill or Kalnapilis in Lithuanian. Kalnapilis beer is brewed according to German traditions and recipes passed down from brewer to brewer and preserved in our archives dating back to 1907. The brand encompasses the entire range of quality German beer, from light Pilsner to the full bodied Royal Select.















Tauras

The Tauras beer brand got its name thanks to the Šopen brewery, which was founded by merchant Vilhelmas Šopenas on the outskirts of Vilnius near Tauras Hill in 1890. Tauras beer is still brewed today using the original recipe of Lietuviško beer.





















Vilkmergės

Vilkmergės is a super premium traditional Lithuanian craft beer. It is crafted following the 18th century traditions. Vilkmergės brewmasters create mostly ale type of beer and have one Premium Lager in their portfolio. Vilkmergės offers beers that are unique, distinctive and rich in taste. Ales are brewed in small batches, using highest quality water, malt and hops.






